2010 Seagrims Tripolis Yacht Race

NOTICE OF RACE

The Port Augusta, Royal Port Pirie & Whyalla Yacht Clubs Combined as the organising authority has contracted the Royal Port Pirie Yacht Club to conduct the 2010 Seagrims Tripolis Yacht Race on the waters of the Upper Spencer Gulf on Tuesday 28th to Thursday 30th December 2010.

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012.
- 1.2 The prescriptions and Special Regulations of Yachting Australia, the regular class rules except as any of these are changed by the Sailing Instructions and the Sailing Instructions will apply.
- 1.3 The regatta will be open to experienced sailors and crew over the age of 16 Age shall be as at the 1st December 2010.

2. **ADVERTISING** - The regatta is classed as Category C, in accordance with the prescriptions of the 2009 ISAF Regulations; refer 20.3.1 (b) AYF.

3. **SAFETY**- The regatta is classified Category 5, in accordance with AYF Special Regulations, Part 1. (Copy of current certificate required with entry).

- 3.1 Radios- A working Marine Radio is mandatory for sailing in unprotected waters. You will ensure that your radio is in a good working order and can give an effective transmission over a reasonable distance and you have sufficient battery power for the duration of the event.

4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The regatta is open to all Entry is open to Mono and Multi Hulled Keel and Trailable type boats of minimum LOA 6.0 metres.
- 4.2 The regatta will be open to experienced sailors and crew over the age of 16 Age shall be as at the 1st December 2010
- 4.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing and returning a 2010 Seagrims Entry Form. Entry Forms are available from Royal Port Pirie Yacht Club, PO Box 116 Port Pirie SA 5540.

All Entries must be lodged with the Royal Port Pirie Yacht Club by 18th December 2010 accompanied with the required fee attached.

- 4.3.1 Late entries will be accepted and must be accompanied with an additional \$10.00 late fee.
- 4.4 The skipper or helmsman of each yacht shall be a financial member of a yacht club affiliated with AYF in accordance with RRS 46 & 75.

5. FEES

- 5.1 The Standard Entry Fee of \$70.00 for Division 1 2 3 and \$50.00 for Cruising only must be paid by all skippers.
- 5.2 The Late Entry Levy of \$10.00 will apply for each boat
- 5.3 All required fees shall be paid when submitting the Seagrims Tripolis Entry Form, which must be lodged by Friday, 18th December 2010.

6. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

6.1 Registration:

All competitors shall register at the Royal Port Pirie Yacht Club before 19:00 hours on Monday, 27th December 2010 to confirm their attendance at the event.

Competitors will be required to sign a safety form at each of the clubs each day before racing.

6.2 Briefing:

A Tripolis briefing will be held at the Royal Port Pirie Yacht club at 20:00 hours on Monday, 27th December 2010.

6.3 Dates of racing:

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at The Royal Port Pirie Yacht Club Prior to registration on Monday 27th December 2010.

8. VENUE

The regatta will conducted on the Upper Spencer Gulf in a Triangle between the three cities of Port Pirie, Port Augusta and. Whyalla

9. THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be detailed in the Sailing instructions that will be made available at registration.

10. PENALTY SYSTEM

- 10.1 Litter and Pollution –Throwing litter overboard or causing pollution a **5 minute Time Penalty**
- 10.2 Motor and Fuel – All Yachts shall carry sufficient fuel at the start of each leg to motor for 8 hours. Failure to comply a **5 minute Time Penalty**
- 10.3 Radio Scheduled Calls – in the event that a yacht is unable to answer a scheduled call, all reasonable effort should be made to contact another vessel in order to be accounted for. **5 minute Time Penalty** in the event of a yacht failing to answer scheduled calls.

11 CHARTS

Metric Charts AUS136 and AUS778 shall be carried by each boat participating'

12. SCORING

12.1 The Bonus Point System of Appendix A will apply. Handicap placing will be calculated for all divisions for each leg of the race. Point will be calculated from AYF 2009-2012, Appendix A4

13. SUPPORT BOATS

Team leaders, coaches and other support personnel shall stay at least 200 metres outside areas where boats are racing from the time of the preparatory signal for the first Division to start until all boats have finished or the race committee signals a postponement, general recall or abandonment.

14. RADIO COMMUNICATION

All Yachts shall carry a working transceiver, either 27MHz Marine with channel 94 and /or VHF Marine with Channel 77.

15 CREW

All Yachts shall carry a minimum of **Three Experienced Crew** over the age of 16years old

16. PRIZES

16.1 Division 1

Keelboats with minimum LOA 6.0mt.

16.2 Division 2

Trailer Sailors with minimum LOA 6.0mt.

16.3 Division 3

Multihull Yachts minimum LOA 6.0mt

16.4 ALL LEGS

Handicap Div. 1, 2, &3 1st, 2nd, 3rd.

Fastest Div. 1, 2, &3 1st

OVERALL HANDICAP

Div. 1, 2 & 3

1st, 2nd, 3rd.

16.5 DIVISIONS

There shall be a minimum of six entrants to form a division, when there are less than 6 boats in a division there will be a reduction in the number of prizes awarded. Where there is 3 Boats that form a division, prizes of 1st, overall & 1st on handicap will be awarded. A minimum of 4 boats the 1st & 2nd overall and on Handicap will be awarded.

17. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

18. INSURANCE

All yachts shall have minimum \$5,000,000 third party liability insurance cover. AYF members Personal Marine TPL policy is acceptable where the policy holder is the person in charge of the vessel, and whose name appears on the entry form. (Certificate copy required with entry)
